ORTHODONTIC RESIDENT SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible, resident applicants from the GLAO programs need to send an application, with image and essay, to TP Orthodontics, Inc. The essay topic will be on humanitarian / volunteer efforts made by the resident during their years of attendance at their orthodontic residency program. Scholarship applications are due by February 15th.

Essays will be reviewed for these specific criteria:

- Humanitarian / volunteer efforts
- Recognized good deed efforts

Application and Submission Process

Scholarship applications, including image and essay, are due by February 15th of each year. Late applications will not be accepted.
