Commission on Dental Accreditation (CODA) Standards Review Taskforce Update

The presentation update will be led by Drs. Steven Siegel and Kelton Stewart and will occur from 10:00-10:45AM on Friday, May 4th in the Independence Salon. This will be one of the final steps before the CODA taskforce finalizes the recommendations that will be sent to the Commission on Dental Accreditation for review and possible implementation. AAO Full-Time Faculty Teaching Fellowship Program

Support for the re-instatement of the AAO Full-Time Faculty Teaching Fellowship Program continues to grow. The program received a favorable review by the AAO Board of Trustees and will be voted upon by the House of Delegates during the annual session in DC. The proposed program would be re-instated for 2019, 2020, and 2021 with three, two-year funded fellowships per year. Each fellow would receive a total of \$60,000 in financial support. The proposed plan will utilize funds from Excess Reserves to cover the projected \$540,000 associated with the program. If ratified by House, the program will provide a much needed avenue to identify, develop, and retain future orthodontic faculty members.

As previously noted; reviving this program will be a benefit to not only our future residents but also the orthodontic profession as a whole.
