

The American Board of Orthodontics 2019 GLAO Constituency Report

July 2019

ABO Mission:

The mission of The American Board of Orthodontics is to elevate the quality of orthodontic care for the public by promoting excellence through certification, education and professional collaboration.

ABO Vision:

The American Board of Orthodontics is the global leader in orthodontic board certification and sets the standards of care for excellence in orthodontics and dentofacial orthopedics.

ABO Yearly Update:

Clinical Examination Update:

- The ABO conducted Clinical Examinations in February and September in 2018 and February 2019. A total of 449 orthodontists were certified/recertified at these examinations. A complete listing by examination and constituency can be found on the [ABO website](#).
- The first Scenario-based Oral Clinical Examination was successfully administered in February 2019 with a 68% pass rate. Traditional Clinical Examinations were also offered by petition only in February 2019. June 2019 marked the final case-based examinations.

Response to the new examination has been overwhelmingly positive. Overall, examinees shared that they were pleased at how well organized and professionally handled the examination details were administered. Feedback received included:

- "Overall, I appreciate the ABO's commitment to strive for excellence and improvement and would recommend any orthodontist take the new exam. I truly feel I have become a better orthodontist because of it."

The next Scenario-based Oral Clinical Examination is scheduled for November 2019 and February 2020. These examinations are full with a wait-list.

Registration for the 2020 exams opened on May 22, 2019. An additional examination has been added due to anticipated demand. Examinations will now be offered February, July and November 2020.

Study materials and online resources are available to assist in preparing for the Scenario-based Oral Clinical Examination including a Study Guide and Sample Cases (with questions and answers). Orthodontic programs interested in hosting case-based mock board exams are welcome to contact ABO examiners to request a school visit. ABO advocates are available to visit orthodontic programs if requested. Prep Courses to assist in preparing for the examination will be offered at various times throughout the year in collaboration with the College (CDABO).

Once board certification is achieved, Certification Renewal is required every 10 years to remain in an Active status and may be taken no earlier than two years prior to the expiration date on your certificate. There are two options to re-certify (travel to St. Louis is NOT required):

- Complete two online Board Case Exams as provided by the Board AND submit CE credits from online AJO-DO exams; or
- Submit one case treated by the examinee (see website for criteria) and submit CE credits from online AJO-DO examinations.

Written Examination Update:

- The 2019 American Board of Orthodontics Written Examination was administered one day only on April 10, 2019 to 422 examinees at Pearson Vue Testing Centers throughout the United States and Canada. The reliability of the examination was 90% with a 96% pass rate. The next Written Examination will be offered on April 7, 2020. Eligible individuals may register for this exam beginning this fall. As a reminder once the Written Examination is successfully completed, it never expires.

- As a reminder, items are available through the ABO educational toolkit for use by ABO certified orthodontists in promoting their certification achievement.
- All board certified orthodontists are strongly encouraged to reset their ABO password to access their personal dashboard on the new software. As a reminder, enhancements include enhanced orthodontist locator, ability to add professional head-shot to profile, ability to edit/add personal and practice information with unlimited offices, increased security, user specific dashboard notifications, make annual fee payments and view payment history, upload and track CE credits, print complimentary verification letter.

Educators Symposium:

- Department Chairs, Program Directors and ABO-appointed Advocates were invited to attend an Educator/Advocate Workshop held during the 2019 AAO Annual Session in

Los Angeles. As a follow-up to last year's session, ABO directors presented updated results and feedback from the February 2019 Scenario-based Oral Clinical Examination, along with a review of preparation materials and how to prepare for the examination. Immediately following the workshop, an Open House/Information Session was held for those wanting to learn more about the examination. In small round-table forums, ABO directors personally reviewed the examination structure with attendees, answered questions and shared materials available to help them prepare.

The College:

- The College (CDABO) offered a Prep Course during the 2019 AAO Annual Session on how to prepare for the ABO Scenario-based Clinical Exam. Demand for the class was great with the class being sold out. Drs. Peter Buschang, Allen Moffitt and Timothy Trulove joined Dr. Daniel Rejman and other CDABO Councilors for the session. The College plans on offering similar prep courses at their upcoming summer meetings, future Annual Sessions and select constituency meetings. In addition, the College will also handle the administrative organization of the advocacy program to continue to reach out and encourage ABO certification at all orthodontic residency programs and ensure there is at least one advocate volunteer assigned at each program.

GORP:
