

ABO Yearly Update

Clinical Exam Update:

The ABO conducted Clinical Examinations in February, June and November of 2019. A total of 247 examinees were certified or recertified during the February and June 2019 examinations. During the November 19th - 22nd, 2019 Clinical exam, a total of 232 orthodontists were certified or recertified. The passing rate was 84%. The ABO currently represents 46 percent of AAO membership. A complete listing of newly certified or recertified orthodontists by constituency is located on the ABO website.

Due to anticipated demand, a third examination has been added in 2020 to include February, July and November. Dates for 2021 examinations will be posted on the ABO website in May 2020.

The 2020 Lindsey O. Kesling Orthodontic Resident Scholarship recipients will be announced at the AAO Annual Session in Atlanta on Saturday, May 2nd, at booth number #1703, time TBD.

The Lindsey O. Kesling Orthodontic Resident Scholarship Award was created to give back to the orthodontic community in a way that helps residents, by easing a small part of their financial burden. Lindsey Kesling just graduated from Indiana University and was beginning a promising career in the orthodontic industry when accidental exposure to carbon monoxide (CO) ended her life at the age of 22. Lindsey was passionate about orthodontics and the industry. Her great grandfather, Dr. Harold D. Kesling, founded TP Orthodontics, Inc. which is still owned by the family today.

TP Orthodontics, Inc. offers the Lindsey O. Kesling Orthodontic Resident Scholarship Award annually, to residents from the orthodontic programs in the GLAO region. Since the inception of the scholarship in 2019, over \$30,000 has been awarded to 14 residents from seven different universities in the GLAO region.
