Remembering Dr. Eugene Dellinger, GLAO Past President, for His Many Contributions to the Orthodontic Profession

Dr. Eugene L. Dellinger worked as an orthodontist for over 40 years before his retirement. Sadly,he passed away on December 7, 2020, although he will long be remembered for his many contributions to the orthodontic profession. He was a member of the Great Lakes Association of Orthodontists, American Association of Orthodontists, American Dental Association, American Board of Orthodontics, College of Diplomats of the American Board of Orthodontics, American College of Dentists, and International College of Dentists. Gene was a past president of the Indiana Association of Orthodontists, past president of the Great Lakes Association of Orthodontists, a past member of the House of Delegates for the American Association of Orthodontists, and served as a Professor at



the Indiana University School of Dentistry Orthodontic Department. He was a recipient of the GLAO Distinguished Service Award in 2016.

The ABO conducted Clinical Examinations in February and November 2020. A total of 203 examinees were certified or recertified at the February examination. A complete listing of names by constituency is located on the ABO website. During the November examination 207 examinees were ABO certified. The average pass rate was 75%. Overall exam reliability was 99% and the Inter- rater reliability was 88%.

A total of 157 orthodontists completed their rectification renewal and maintained their ABO status.

The ABO currently represents 49 percent of AAO membership.

The February 2020 Clinical Examination was held in St. Louis in the Scenario-based Oral Examination format. However, in response to safety requirements recommended by the CDC due to COVID-19, an alternative testing option for the Clinical Examination was identified and announced in July 2020. The July 2020 Clinical Examination was cancelled, with examinees having the opportunity to reschedule to a future examination.

Beginning with the November 2020 Clinical Examination and for 2021 Clinical Exams scheduled in February, and November, the examinations will take place at Scantron Testing Centers Worldwide. Travel to St. Louis will no longer be required. The examination will continue to be administered in a scenario-based format with the same exam components and testing criteria. The validity of the exam will be maintained with changes only made to accommodate how answers are submitted. Exams will continue to be scored by multiple ABO examiners to ensure accuracy and consistency for each exam section.

To-date, all future examinations are full with wait-lists, with the exception of the November 2021 date which is currently open. Complete details regarding the Clinical Examination, study materials and how to prepare can be found on the ABO website.

Applications Available for the GLAO and TP Orthodontics 2021 Lindsey O. Kesling Orthodontic Resident Scholarship Award


Applications for the 2021 Lindsey O. Kesling Orthodontic Resident Scholarship Award are now available. Applications are due by May 1, 2021. Recipients will be announced during the GLAO Member Business Meeting at the GLAO Annual Session in Indianapolis, on Friday, October 15, 2021.

The Lindsey O. Kesling Orthodontic Resident Scholarship Award was created to give back to the orthodontic community in a way that helps residents, by easing a small part of their financial burden. Lindsey Kesling just graduated from Indiana University and was beginning a promising career in the orthodontic industry when accidental exposure to carbon monoxide (CO) ended her life at the age of 22. Lindsey was passionate about orthodontics and the industry. Her great grandfather, Dr. Harold D. Kesling, founded TP Orthodontics, Inc. which is still owned by the family today.

TP Orthodontics, Inc. has partnered with the GLAO to offer the Lindsey O. Kesling Orthodontic Resident Scholarship Award annually, to residents from orthodontic programs in the GLAO region. Since the inception of the scholarship in 2017, nearly \$40,000 in scholarships has been awarded to 18 residents from seven different universities in the GLAO region. In addition, over \$9,000 in product vouchers has been awarded to fifteen additional applicants.
