Coding and Member Education

- National Association of Dental Plans (NADP)
 - The NADP will be meeting in St. Louis in September
 - The AAO will be planning an event to connect AAO members with NADP leadership
- American Association of Dental Consultants (AADC)
 - AADC will be meeting in Phoenix in May 2023
 - The AAO will coordinate with the AADC to plan a meeting with AAO leadership
- ADA Code Maintenance Committee (CMC)
 - The 2022 meeting allowed for some of the AAO's Code Action Requests to be accepted
 - The Council discussed issues that may impact the CDT code in 2023 including:
 - Growth modification separate from orthodontic treatment
 - Dentition definitions
 - Retainer codes
 - 3D surface scans
 - Artificial intelligence
- The Coding Subcommittee created a Member Coding Survey in order to obtain information from AAO Membership re: coding

Member Education Resources

The Council discussed opportunities to increase member resources and educational opportunities as they pertain to benefits. Opportunities for the Council in the upcoming years include:

- Methods of reaching Treatment/Financial Coordinators
- Update the AAO's Coding 101 Webinar
- Using Components/Constituents to share information
- The Council is working with the AAO Marketing Team to add revised Claims Tip Sheets, new resources to the AAO Website, and creating an outline for a Claims Submission Manual in order to reach Treatment/Financial Coordinators.

Policy on FrequencyAge/Other Limitations

- The Council discussed the recommendation to the BOT that the AAO adopt a policy that does not deny orthodontic benefits based on age, treatment frequency, stage of development, patient health or disability, or any other limitation.

Claims Data

- The Council discussed the benefits and usefulness to the AAO, AAO Members, and Councils of collecting claims data.
- The Council will explore opportunities for engagement with companies who hold this type of information.

CDT 2.0

- The Council is focusing on upcoming changes to the CDT code and code modifiers associated with orthodontic treatment in preparation for these changes.
