MIDWESTERN SOCIETY OF ORTHODONTISTS 2017 EARL E. SHEPARD DISTINGUISHED SERVICE AWARD

Dr Dennis D. Sommers



The MSO Board of Directors unanimously selected Dr Dennis D. Sommers of Minot, North Dakota, as the recipient of the 2017 Earl E. Shepard Distinguished Service Award. This award recognizes a member of the MSO who exemplifies the ideals of the orthodontic profession, community and family.

Dr Sommers became involved with dental organizations, serving as President of North Dakota's Northwest District Dental Society and other local and regional dental society positions, later becoming President of the North Dakota Dental Association in 2009. Similarly, Dennis served a number of years as President of the North Dakota Society of Orthodontists before completing eight years as its Director to the MSO and later as MSO's Representative on the AAO Council on Membership, Ethics and Judicial Concerns. He has served in both AAO and ADA Houses of Delegates, lobbied before the North Dakota Legislature and in Washington, D.C. regarding dental issues with both the ADA and AAO.

Dr Martin Dewey was active in numerous SWSO programs. Many have graduated from his Dewey School of Orthodontia. The Martin Dewey award is the most highly esteemed honor recognizing those who have made remarkable contributions to the advancements of the orthodontics field. This year's recipient is Dr Larry W. White.

Dr White practiced general dentistry for five years, then returned to Baylor Dental College to earn a graduate degree in orthodontics. He practiced orthodontics in Hobbs for 31 years, then began an academic career by starting the University of Texas Health Science Center - San Antonio's first graduate orthodontic program. Dr White has published over 100 professional articles, authored several books about orthodontics, and edited numerous professional publications. Dr. White continues to practice orthodontics and teach in the Orthodontic Department at Baylor Dental College.

Until about 2 decades ago, orthodontics was perceived by our dental colleagues as an endeavor wrapped in the inscrutability of cephalometric x-rays and all those measurements! Since that time, with the evolution of the soft tissue paradigm, the adoption of interdisciplinary treatment, and meteoric changes in technology, many orthodontic treatment plans now are in lockstep with how dentists evaluate smiles. The interaction of the two is a very important concept, but smile design, while important, is not the entire picture. This presentation will cover how adolescent care has been redesigned to address smile design and Macroesthetic concerns in a very positive manner, and how orthodontists with knowledge of growth development of hard- and soft-tissue serve as an ideal quarterback of the interdisciplinary team.

A challenge for growth in orthodontics is an evidence-based clinical perspective. Dr "Wick" Alexander said that orthodontics is simple, but with this caveat, "Simple does not necessarily equal easy." Consistent with this aphorism, the theme of this presentation is the discussion of some rather simple philosophies and principles that I believe are worthy of reflection. This presentation offers examples of important lessons from 40 years of "practice." The majority of this presentation consists of case presentations with appropriate literature/evidence, and emphasis on key points.
