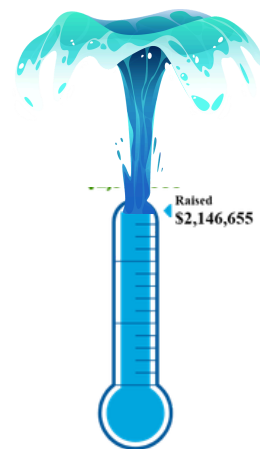
For the Future Campaign
